



Worship Director

Time Commitment: Sunday Mornings (approx. 7am – 12:30pm); Weekly rehearsals (historically Thursday evenings 7pm to 8:30pm), in addition to any necessary meetings, and special Worship services during the year. Preparatory hours are spent both on and off site.

Hours: 15-20 hours a week on week (varies based on meetings & season)

Reports to: Senior Pastor

Worship Director Responsibilities

- Contagious, Christ-focused Contemporary Song and Worship leadership during Sunday services and special Worship services throughout the year, including singing, prayer and planning
- Regular review of Worship, including songs, different parts of Worship, themes, and potential events, in conjunction with the Pastor and Believe Team
- Recruitment of new band participants and leadership in assimilation and support
- Recruitment, scheduling and support of Special Music participants during services
- Oversight of Audio and Video teams, including backup scheduling for Sundays and special services
- Oversight of equipment and systems for audio/video/livestreaming. Creation of song slides for each week and loaded into presentation software. Gain familiarity over our sound and video systems, with ability to use each
- Budget management
- Join with other staff and lay leadership as an ambassador for Cornerstone and our ministries, that we may continue to serve God, to love our neighbors, and to proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ
- Regular attendance at Believe Team and staff meetings. Welcome and encouraged to attend CLT meetings/events.

- Regular communication and coordination with Music Director is key on above topics as well as determining of who will lead or play particular songs. Utilization of Music Director for support on musical arrangements for songs as needed.
- Weekly worship leadership schedule should be planned at least 4 weeks in advance and provided to the Pastor and Band (including any updates/changes to the schedule).
- Oversee song selection in coordination with the Pastor, Music Director and Band members, following themes and seasons; including regular communication of upcoming Worship sets with Band
- Regular communication/partnership with our Music Director for planning and oversight of practice and structure of songs and Worship sets, including scheduling and preparation.

Job Qualifications

A commitment to Christ and to the work of Worship and assisting others in their worship of God; past experience in Christian Worship leadership including singing and instrumentals; ability to lead public prayers; proficiency with an instrument conducive to Worship (guitar or keyboard); ability to organize and support a praise band, in conjunction with our Music Director; dependability on a weekly basis for two Sunday services and one practice session; ability to select songs and hymns that fit themes for seasons and sermon series; excellent communication skills, including ability to communicate interpersonally, through the written word, and via public speaking; commitment to foster an atmosphere in Worship that is Christ-focused, inclusive of different peoples and participants, and contemporary in style; technical understanding of audio/video/livestreaming equipment and systems; ability to work closely with the Pastor, Music Director, Band Members, Audio and Video teams, Believe Team and other Worship leaders.
